CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entries are limited to allow the works to be displayed adequately.

- Entry is open to residents of the Shires of Augusta Margaret River, Busselton and Nannup, over the age of 17.
- Entry fee is \$20 (non-refundable).
- Artworks can be 2D or 3D and must weigh less than 50kgs.
- All work will be exhibited outdoors and undercover options will be available.
- All work must be delivered and collected from the exhibition venue by the artist.
- It will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange delivery of sold pieces to the buyer.
- All works must be for sale at a realistic price with a 25% commission to go to Arts Margaret River.
- Arts Margaret River reserves the right to refuse an artwork on merit or suitability for general public viewing or safety.
- Artists to supply a brief Artist Statement & photograph of artwork with entry form.
- The artists agree to their work being reproduced in print, film and digital format for promotion, funding applications and acquittals, online and in the media.
- Whilst all due care is taken with exhibits, Arts Margaret River accepts no liability for any loss or damage while the exhibits are in its custody. Artists are responsible for insuring their work.
