



## Themes of Collection

In collecting in the various areas, emphasis will be placed on the following themes where relevant -

- 1. personal identity as expressed through self-portraits and portraiture
- 2. still life
- 3. the domestic environment
- 4. children and family life
- the Southwest environment.

## **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Entry is open to all Cape-to-Cape region artists aged over 18. This extends from Busselton down to Augusta.
- 2. Up to two entries are allowed per artist.
- 3. Submitted artworks should directly address the stated themes of the Capecare Art Collection.
- 4. The exhibition excludes photography and 3D pieces.\*Contact us with any questions around your entry's eligibility.
- 5. All entries must include a photograph of the artwork and the completed Acquisition Proposal Form. By entering, the artist agrees to any acquired works being reproduced in print, film, and digital format for promotion.
- 6. A weight restriction of 20kgs maximum applies for all works. Artworks should also not exceed 120cm in width or 150cm in height.
- 7. Artworks must be for sale for a reasonable price and for no more than \$2,000 including commission and GST where applicable. Artist are also welcome to donate suitable artworks to the collection.
- 8. Arts Margaret River and Capecare reserves the right to refuse any artwork based on merit, suitability for general public viewing and/or safety concerns.
- 9. A pre-selection will be made and short-listed artworks must be delivered to Arts Margaret River between 10am-2pm on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021 unless alternative arrangements have been made with Arts Margaret River.
- 10. It will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange delivery and/or collection of their artworks at their own expense.
- 11. All artworks must be suitably framed and/or stretched with D-rings and cord, ready to hang or install.
- 12. While all due care is taken with artworks, Arts Margaret River and Capecare accepts no liability for any loss or damage while the artworks are in our custody. Artists are responsible for insuring their artwork during the assessment phase.
- 13. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 14. Acquisitions pieces will be announced by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021.
- 15. Non-acquired artworks are to be collected from Arts Margaret River by 9th July 2021.
