CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ARTWORK

- 1. Original Artwork -Entry is open to artists over 17, residing in the Augusta Margaret River Shire, Busselton Shire and Shire of Nannup.
- 2. Up to two entries are allowed per artist. A weight restriction of 20kgs maximum applies for hanging artworks.
- 3. The competition and exhibition excludes 3D pieces weighing over 40kgs (entries are limited to allow the works to be displayed adequately). Contact us with any questions around your entry's eligibility.
- 4. Artworks must be for sale at a realistic price, with a minimum 50% commission going to ArtsMR.
- 5. All works must be suitably framed and / or stretched with D ring and cord, ready to hang or install.
- 6. Artworks must be delivered to the Margaret River HEART between 10am 2pm on Monday 9 January unless alternative arrangements have been made with ArtsMR.
- Artworks will be subject to a process of curation and a limited number of works will be accepted. ArtsMR reserves the right to refuse artworks that are deemed not suitable.
- 8. All entries must include a photograph of the artwork. By entering, the artist agrees to their work being reproduced in print, film and digital format for promotion and funding purposes.
- While all due care is taken with exhibits, ArtsMR accepts no liability for any loss or damage while the artworks are in our custody. Artists are responsible for insuring their work.

RESTART

- 1. Original artwork created by WA artists only will be considered.
- 2. Locals residing in the Augusta Margaret River Shire, Busselton Shire and Shire of Nannup can submit up to two artworks for consideration.
- 3. Artworks must be in good condition and for sale at a realistic price, with a minimum 50% commission going to ArtsMR. A compulsory 5% Resale Royalty Fee (administered by the Copyright Agency) will also apply if the sale value of the artwork is over \$1000 and the artwork was acquired by the current owner after 2010.
- 4. Restart artworks will be subject to a process of curation and a limited number of works will be accepted. ArtsMR reserves the right to refuse artworks that are deemed not suitable.
- 5. Artworks must be delivered to the Margaret River HEART between Monday 5th December to Thursday 8th December (10am 4pm) for appraisal and selection.
- 6. Unsuitable artworks must be collected from the Margaret River HEART by Thursday 15th December 2022.

3) Boards - We will supply you with a 150mm x 150mm board that you can paint and donate to us for silent auction at the event. Boards can be collected from the ArtsMR office at the Community Centre from Monday 30 October 2022 (Mon to Thur 10am - 4pm).

The 2022 Art in the Garden Fundraiser was sold-out with over 200 people attending and it raised essential funds to support Arts Margaret River's work within our community.

Next year's event will be held at Howard Park and we anticipate a similar number of people attending. We will advertise the event widely and promote all participating artists, providing you and your work with great exposure.

Your participation will help us to raise funds to continue our mission to support and nurture the work of artists across all disciplines, and to foster a love of the arts and social cohesion within our community.

Entries open 1st November 2022 and close Monday 9th January 2023.
